To Camden Middle School Families,

At the 2 September 2021 Camden County Schools (CCS) Board of Education (BOE) meeting, the CCS BOE updated the CCS COVID Mitigation Plan. The below information is provided to keep everyone informed of how we are following the Strong School NC Public Health Tool Kit and the CCS COVID Mitigation Plan.

- In classrooms and spaces at CMS that will allow students to maintain a minimum of 3 feet distance between students, masks are optional.
- In classrooms and spaces that students cannot maintain a minimum of 3 feet distance, masks are required. Some examples of when masks are required:
 - In classrooms where students cannot maintain 3 feet of distance,
 - When students are changing classes,
 - When students are going to and from the cafeteria,
 - When waiting in line in the cafeteria,
 - When students are going to and from the restroom,
 - When students are transitioning or moving around in a classroom,
 - In locker rooms when changing for Physical Education,
 - Anytime students cannot maintain a minimum of 3 feet distance,
- We are still working out the details for keeping children three feet apart in the cafeteria. Most likely, some classes will eat lunch in the cafeteria and some classes will eat in their 5th-period classroom.
- The CMS Nurse, Principal, or Assistant Principal, will contact the parents or guardians of any child that is required to quarantine.
- If a child has to be quarantined, their teachers will maintain contact with them via email and post assignments in the Canvas Classroom. Teachers will also provide instruction through live-streaming classes, zooming with students, or recording lessons for students.
- CMS students can take part in sport and extracurricular activities.
 - Masks are not required while students are actively participating in sports or school programs.

- Audience members, spectators, administrators, athletes on the sidelines, and coaches will be required to wear masks when inside during athletics, school programs, and extracurricular activities.
- During extracurricular activities such as club meetings, attendees will be required to wear masks when students cannot maintain 3 feet distance.
- When traveling to other school districts, the guidelines of that district will apply to all CMS staff, students, athletes, and spectators.

Please ensure your child has a mask every day. If your child forgets his or her mask, we will provide one for them.

The Camden Middle School staff is working hard to ensure every child is safe and is provided the best education possible. Please let us know if you have any questions or concerns.
